Four Corners Power Plant & Navajo Mine Energy Project (FCPP-NMEP)

The Four Corners Power Plant & Navajo Mine Energy Project (FCPP & NMEP) includes renewal of leases and rights of way for the Four Corners Power Plant and Navajo Mine as well as a new mining permit called the Pinabete Permit in the Navajo Mine Lease area and renewal of the Navajo Mine Permit. OSMRE is the lead federal agency in preparing an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) for this project. The Notice of Availability (NOA) for FCPP & NMEP Draft Environmental Impact Statement (DEIS) was published in the Federal Register on March 28, 2014. The NOA of the DEIS will be noticed in newspapers and announced on radio stations located on or near the Hopi and Navajo reservations. Radio announcements will be in English, Hopi and Navajo languages.

In addition to the NOA for the DEIS, public meeting dates and locations are being noticed in newspapers and announced on radio stations located on or near the Hopi and Navajo reservations. Radio announcements will be in English, Hopi and Navajo languages. Public meetings on the DEIS will be held on:

The public comment period on the DEIS began on March 28 and ends on May 27, 2014.

Note: On February 4, 2014, the Navajo Mine Permit was transferred to Navajo Transitional Energy Company (NTEC), a Navajo Nation business entity.

Navajo Generating Station & Kayenta Mine Complex Project (NGS-KMC)

Notice of Intent (NOI) to prepare an EIS for the Navajo Generating Station & Kayenta Mine Complex (NGS-KMC) is currently scheduled to be published in the Federal Register on May 16, 2014. The Bureau of Reclamation (USBR) is the lead federal agency preparing this EIS. The NOI will begin the public scoping period for the NGS-KMC project EIS. The NOI will be noticed in newspapers and announced on radio stations located on or near the Hopi and Navajo reservations. Radio announcements will be in Hopi and Navajo languages. The announcements will include the public scoping comment period, and locations of public scoping meeting locations.

Following OSMRE's review of the Kayenta Life of Mine (LOM) permit revision application, submitted by Peabody Western Coal Company (PWCC) on May 1, 2012, as amended by subsequent update submittals dated December 18, 2013, and February 10, 2014, OSMRE found the application to be administratively complete on March 5, 2014. This determination allowed public notices in newspapers and announcements on radio stations located on or near the Hopi and Navajo reservations, to begin. These publications announced the availability of the LOM application for public review. In addition to English, the radio announcements were provided in Hopi and Navajo languages. Public notices on the LOM application began on March 13 and ended on April 3, 2014. The public comment period for the LOM application began on March 13, 2014, and ends on May 5, 2014.
