**San Juan Mine Deep Lease Extension Project
Environmental Impact Statement**

Pursuant to the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA), the Office of Surface Mining Reclamation and Enforcement (OSMRE) is preparing an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) for the San Juan Coal Company's proposed mining plan modification for the Deep Lease Extension (DLE) at the existing underground San Juan Mine. The San Juan Mine supplies the San Juan Generating Station with coal and this action would extend mining operations through 2033. The EIS will address the direct, indirect and cumulative impacts of the proposed underground mining operations, as well as potential coal combustion related impacts at the San Juan Generating Station.
