Of The

**San Juan Mine Deep Lease Extension Mining Plan Modification
Final Environmental Impact Statement**

The Office of Surface Mining Reclamation and Enforcement (OSMRE) has prepared a Final Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) for the San Juan Coal Company's proposed mining plan modification for the Deep Lease Extension (DLE) at the existing underground San Juan Mine, located near Waterflow, New Mexico. The San Juan Mine supplies the San Juan Generating Station with coal and the proposed action would extend mining operations through 2033. The Final EIS analyzes the direct, indirect and cumulative impacts of the proposed underground mining operations, alternatives, and the potential coal combustion related impacts at the San Juan Generating Station.
