

OFFICIAL NOTICE

Pursuant to Title 40, Section 1506.6 of the Code of Federal Regulations, the Office of Surface Mining Reclamation and Enforcement (OSMRE), Denver Field Branch, gives notice of the availability of a Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) prepared in response to our receipt and analysis of the South Canyon #1 Coal Mine Fire Abatement - East Cover Project Environmental Assessment (EA). The EA examines potential environmental impacts related to an Abandoned Mine Land (AML) reclamation project in the City of Glenwood Springs Open Space, Garfield County, Colorado.

The South Canyon #1 Coal Mine Fire Abatement - East Cover AML project involves excavating, capping, regrading, and revegetating approximately three acres of lands damaged by an underground mine fire in Garfield County. OSMRE is providing funding to the Colorado Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety's Inactive Mine Reclamation Program to complete this project.
