

OFFICIAL NOTICE

Pursuant to Title 40, Section 1506.6 of the Code of Federal Regulations, the Office of Surface Mining Reclamation and Enforcement's (OSMRE) Denver Field Branch gives notice of the availability of a Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) prepared in response to our receipt and analysis of the Spor Mountain Environmental Assessment (EA). The EA examines potential environmental impacts related to an Abandoned Mine Land (AML) reclamation project in Juab County, Utah.

The Spor Mountain AML project will safeguard 75 hazardous abandoned mine openings associated with the Spor Mountain Mining District. The work will include hand and machine backfill plus construction of concrete block walls, steel gates, polyurethane foam plugs, and steel barriers. The project would disturb approximately eight acres on private and federal (Bureau of Land Management) property. OSMRE is providing funding to the Utah Division of Oil, Gas & Mining's Abandoned Mine Reclamation Program to complete this project.
